- 1. Place flowers, leaves, vegetables, etc. on a piece of mordanted fabric.
- 2. Fold it. The way you fold it will help create patterns. If you don't want colors to bleed through the folds separate the layers with foil, paper, or saran wrap.
- 3. Roll the folded fabric around a stick or pipe or fold/roll it to a little hard package. Roll it up tight.
- 4. Put the rolled up/folded fabric in a steamer basket in a pot with a small amount of boiling water. Or hang the folded package in a string down in the pot with a little water on the bottom. Or place a pipe with rolled up fabric on a metal rack with just a little of water underneath the rack.
- 5. Do not let the water touch the fabric.
- 6. Steam for 20 mins or so.
- 7. Unfold.
- 8. You can experiment with acid/alkaline/iron, dip the fabric or sprinkle chemicals on it.
- 9. Rinse, or (if you did not use chemicals) you can let dry and then rinse at a later time.
